PERFORMANCES

Ballet 1, 2, and 3 Students will perform in the 10:00 am performance only on Sunday, December 3rd. Students in Ballet & Tap 2/3 on Tuesdays at 3:45 pm will perform as Snow Princesses. Students in Ballet, Hip-hop & Acro 2/3 on Thursdays at 3:45 pm will perform as Chinese. Students in Ballet, Aerial & Acro 1/2 on Saturdays at 9:45 am will perform as Dolls.

Ballet 4 Students on Mondays at 3:45 pm will perform in the 10:00 am performance only on Sunday, December 3rd. They will perform as Cherubs.

<u>Ballet 4/5B Students will perform in both the 10:00 am and 2:00 pm</u> <u>performances on Sunday, December 3rd.</u> Students in Ballet 4/5B on Tuesdays at 4:30 pm will perform as Party Girls and Soldiers. Students in Ballet 4/5B on Thursdays at 4:00 pm will perform as Mirliton.

Ballet 5A and 6 Students will perform in both the 10:00 am and 2:00 pm performances on Sunday, December 3rd.

Aerial & Acro Basics Students will perform in the 10:00 am performance only on Sunday, December 3rd. Students from all Aerial & Acro Basics classes will perform as Dolls.

Acro Int/Adv Students will perform in the 10:00 am performance only on Sunday, December 3rd. Students in Contemporary & Acro Int on Mondays at 5:15 pm and Acro Adv on Wednesdays at 5:15 pm will perform as Russian Acrobats.

ARRIVAL

Please arrive performance-ready with hair and makeup complete.

Ballet 1, 2 and 3 Students should arrive wearing their costume with pink tights and pink Ballet shoes. Hair should be slicked straight back into a neat bun. Minimal stage makeup is optional.

Ballet 4 Students (Monday at 3:45 pm) should arrive wearing a black leotard (camisole or short-sleeve) with pink tights and pink Ballet shoes. Hair should be slicked back into a neat bun. Minimal stage makeup is optional.

Ballet 4/5B Students (Tuesday at 5:30 pm, Thursday at 4:00 pm) should arrive wearing warm-up clothing with pink tights and skin-colored leotards underneath. If you don't have a nude leotard, it is okay to wear a black one. Stage makeup should be complete and hair should be slicked straight back into a neat bun.

Ballet 5A and 6 Students should arrive wearing warm-up clothing with pink tights and skin-colored leotards / undergarments underneath. Stage makeup should be complete and hair should be slicked back into a neat bun.

Acro Basics Students should arrive wearing their costumes. Hair should be slicked back into a low ponytail and jewelry should be removed. Minimal stage makeup is optional.

Acro Int/Adv Students should arrive wearing skin-colored leotards / undergarments underneath. If you don't have a nude leotard, it is okay to wear a black one. Hair should be slicked straight back into a high ponytail and jewelry should be removed. Stage makeup is encouraged.

DROP OFF

All students, families, and guests should enter CMS through the main entrance. This brings you directly to the auditorium lobby. There will BKS team members and volunteers in the lobby checking the students in and walking to their designated area in the dressing room. Students will sit with their volunteers until they are called to line up in the wings.

Please note that all students should be dropped off in the lobby. Parents are not allowed in the dressing rooms or backstage. Only students, volunteers, and BKS / CMS staff should be in the dressing rooms or backstage for liability reasons.

Students should only bring essential performance items to the dressing room. Please label all belongings with the student's name. BKS / CMS is not responsible for any lost or damaged items.

Ballet & Tap 2/3 Students (Tuesday at 3:45 pm) will be dismissed at intermission during the 10:00 am performance.

Ballet, Hip-hop & Acro 2/3 Students (Thursday at 3:45 pm) will be dismissed at the end of the 10:00 am performance.

Ballet, Aerial & Acro 1/2 Students (Saturday at 9:45 am) will be dismissed at intermission during the 10:00 am performance.

As we travel down the route, students are encouraged to dance, wave, and cheer.

Be sure to pack food and water for the day, and please plan ahead for any predicted weather. In the past, parents have driven to the ending point of the parade to meet their children as they finish.

The final apparel order will be placed on Friday, October 20th to give enough time for the shipment to arrive before Nutcracker weekend. If you wish to be included on the apparel order, please let us know by Friday, October 20th at noon.

HAIR

Ballet Students should arrive with their hair slicked straight back into a neat, high bun with no part. Buns should be flat and even, with a tight hold. Use elastics, hair nets, and pins that match the hair color. Headpieces should be securely pinned to the right side of the dancer's bun. Please bring extra bobby pins for pinning headpieces.

Acro Students should arrive with their hair slicked back into a neat ponytail. Acro Basics students will wear a low ponytail. Acro Int/Adv students will wear a high ponytail with no part. Use elastics that match the hair color. Ponytails should have a tight hold and they should be centered.

Step-by-step

- 1. Start with damp, brushed hair. Gather all hair into one section at the top-back of the head. Evenly apply hair gel and use a comb to sweep hair straight back into a tight grip.
- 2. Confirm the height and neatness, then loop a hair elastic around the ponytail tightly. Use more than one elastic and match the elastic to the hair color.
- 3. To continue to a Ballet bun, twist the ponytail itself, then coil it around the base of the ponytail staying flat to the head. The bun should spiral outward, not stack up on top of itself.
- 4. Use U-shaped hairpins to secure the bun. Wrap a hairnet around the bun two or three times, then add more pins. Pins and hairnets should match the hair color.
- 5. Headpieces must lay flat and be securely pinned to the right side of the dancer's bun or ponytail. There should be no headpieces falling off on stage.



MAKEUP


Why? Performers wear stage makeup to accentuate their existing, natural beauty. We understand full glam can feel extreme, especially for younger students. Please know these guidelines are in place to benefit the dancer. Bright stage lights, far distances, and flashy costumes make it easy to appear washed out on stage. Stage makeup enhances the visibility of facial features - allowing expressions to shine through.

MAKEUP REQUIREMENTS BY AGE

Students in Ballet 4/5B, 5A, 6, and Company should wear full BKS stage makeup.

Students in Ballet 1, 2, 3, and 4 are not required to wear any stage makeup. If they wish to wear makeup, they should please follow the BKS stage makeup guidelines.

Acro Students are not required to wear any stage makeup. If they wish to wear makeup, they should please follow the BKS stage makeup guidelines.

COSTUMES

Aerial & Acro Basics Students - Dolls

Students should arrive performance-ready, wearing their costume without tights. Hair should be slicked back into a low ponytail upon arrival. Any jewelry should be removed at home. Minimal stage makeup is optional. The students will perform barefoot, but they will need slip-on shoes to wear backstage. Acro Basics students will wear their costumes home and will keep the costumes. Please do not arrive at the theatre with anything other than their costume and a water bottle.

Acro Int/Adv Students - Russian Acrobats

Students should arrive performance-ready, wearing warm-up clothing with skin-colored leotards / undergarments underneath. If you don't have a nude leotard, it is okay to wear a black one. Hair should be slicked straight back into a high ponytail upon arrival. Any jewelry should be removed at home. Stage makeup is encouraged. The students will perform barefoot, but they will need slip-on shoes to wear backstage. The Russian Acrobat costumes will be hung up in the dressing room when the students arrive. Acro Int/Adv students will not keep their costumes. Before being dismissed, the students should take their costumes off and leave them in the dressing room.

Ballet & Tap 2/3 (Tuesdays at 3:45 pm) - Snow Princesses

Students should arrive performance-ready, wearing their costume with pink tights and pink Ballet slippers. Hair should be slicked straight back into a neat bun upon arrival. Minimal stage makeup is optional. Any jewelry should be removed at home. It is important that all tights are clean and do not have holes or runs. Please make sure all elastics on the student's Ballet shoes are tied and tucked. We encourage the dancers to bring extra bobby pins for pinning headpieces. The students will wear their Snow Princess costumes home and will keep the costumes. Please do not arrive at the theatre with anything other than their costume and a water bottle.

Ballet, Hip-hop & Acro 2/3 (Thursday at 3:45 pm) - Chinese

Students should arrive performance-ready, wearing their costume with pink tights and pink Ballet slippers. Hair should be slicked straight back into a neat bun upon arrival. Minimal stage makeup is optional. Any jewelry should be removed at home. It is important that all tights are clean and do not have holes or runs. Please make sure all elastics on the student's Ballet shoes are tied and tucked. We encourage the dancers to bring extra bobby pins for pinning headpieces. The students will wear their Chinese costumes home and will keep the costumes. Please do not arrive at the theatre with anything other than their costume and a water bottle.

Ballet, Aerial & Acro 1/2 (Saturday at 9:45 am) - Dolls

Students should arrive performance-ready, wearing their costume without tights. Hair should be slicked back into a low ponytail upon arrival. Any jewelry should be removed at home. Minimal stage makeup is optional. The students will perform barefoot, but they will need slip-on shoes to wear backstage. Acro Basics students will wear their costumes home and will keep the costumes. Please do not arrive at the theatre with anything other than their costume and a water bottle.

Ballet 4 (Monday at 3:45 pm) - Cherubs

Students should arrive performance-ready, wearing a leotard with pink tights and pink Ballet slippers. We recommend a camisole or short-sleeve leotard, as they will wear this leotard under their white cherub costumes. Hair should be slicked straight back into a neat bun upon arrival. Minimal stage makeup is optional. Any jewelry should be removed at home. It is important that all tights are clean and do not have holes or runs. Please make sure all elastics on the student's Ballet shoes are tied and tucked. We encourage the dancers to bring extra bobby pins for pinning headpieces. The cherubs costumes will be hung up in their designated section of the dressing room when they arrive. Ballet 4 students will not keep their costumes. Before being dismissed, the students will take their cherubs costumes off and leave them in the dressing room.

Ballet 4/5B (Tuesday at 5:30 pm, Thursday at 4:00 pm) - Party Girls, Soldiers, Mirliton

All Party Girls must bring their own party dresses with them from home. Students should arrive performance-ready, wearing pink tights, pink Ballet shoes, and a leotard for warm-up. Ballet 4/5B students do not need to purchase a skin-colored leotard, but if they have one they should wear it. Upon arrival, hair should be slicked straight back into a neat bun

and stage makeup should be complete. Any jewelry besides Company earrings should be removed at home. It is important that all tights are clean and do not have holes or runs. Please make sure all elastics on the student's Ballet shoes are tied and tucked. We encourage the dancers to bring extra bobby pins for pinning headpieces. All Party Girls must bring their own party dresses with them from home. The Solider and Mirliton costumes will be hung up in their designated section of the dressing room when they arrive. Ballet 4/5B students will not keep their Soldier or Mirliton costumes. Before being dismissed, the students will take their Soldier and Mirliton costumes off and leave them in the dressing room. Party dresses should go back home with the student.

Ballet 5A and 6 - Mice, Spanish, Snow Flurries, Snowflakes, Flowers, Leads

Students should arrive performance-ready, wearing a leotard for warm-up with pink tights, and skin-colored leotards / undergarments. Upon arrival, hair should be slicked straight back into a neat bun and stage makeup should be complete. Any jewelry besides Company earrings should be removed at home. It is important that all tights are clean and do not have holes or runs. Please make sure all shoe ribbons and elastics are tied and tucked. We encourage the dancers to bring extra bobby pins for pinning headpieces. Ballet 5A and 6 costumes will be hung up in the dressing room when they arrive. Ballet 5A and 6 students will not keep their costumes. Before being dismissed, the students will take their costumes off and leave them in the dressing room.
