ARRIVAL

Students performing in the 9:30 am show should arrive to the theatre by 8:30 am. Please plan ahead for potential traffic. All performers should arrive performance-ready. This means wearing full costume, hair slicked back, make-up done, and jewelry removed. Students performing in both the Aerial and Dance Program should pack their tutus, pink tights, bun supplies, Ballet shoes, and Tap shoes (if applicable). Be sure to label all items with the student's name, and please only bring items essential to the performance.

Students performing in the 1:30 pm show should arrive to the theatre by 12:30 pm. Please plan ahead for potential traffic. All performers should arrive performance-ready. This means wearing full costume, hair slicked back, make-up done, and jewelry removed. Students performing in both the Aerial and Dance Program should pack their tutus, pink tights, bun supplies, Ballet shoes, and Tap shoes (if applicable). Be sure to label all items with the student's name, and please only bring items essential to the performance.

STUDENT DROP OFF


Students participating in the Spring Performance can be dropped off at the Paul Creative Arts Center Main Entrance. The BKS Faculty will be set up directly in front of the PCAC to greet the students and walk them to their dressing room. We encourage families to drive straight down Academic Way until you reach the Paul Creative Arts Center on your right. You will see a sidewalk sign marking the drop-off point, and the building is clearly marked (photo below). There is a turn-around in the road directly after the drop off point which leads your straight to B Lot (photo below). All guests should park in Parking Lot B. After parking, guests will enter the Johnson Theatre through the Lobby entrance, not the PCAC student drop-off entrance. The Johnson Theatre lobby entrance is just past the Paul Creative Arts Center on the right (photo below).

Parking -

We recommend all guests park in B Lot, which is located on McDaniel Drive in Durham, NH. Parking in B Lot is free on the weekends. This is the largest parking lot on this side campus, and it will not be used for commencement purposes. Families can drop students off at the Theatre and then park in B Lot. There is a turn-around in front of the Paul Creative Arts Center.


After you park, walk straight down the road to the Paul Creative Arts Center. The Johnson Theatre is located inside the PCAC. Coming from B Lot, you will walk down Academic Way until you reach a flight of outdoor stairs on the right. This brings you to Johnson Theatre lobby entrance.

Directions -


Please be sure to plan ahead and budget additional travel time for potential traffic. We recommend taking the back roads to avoid Main Street because there are commencement ceremonies scheduled at UNH on May 20th.

From Route 108, turn onto Mill Pond Road, which will become Oyster River Road. Turn right onto Mill Road, and then turn left onto McDaniel Drive. Parking Lot B is located on McDaniel Drive, and is a 5-minute walk away from the Johnson Theatre.


Walking Map - B Lot to Johnson Theatre

COSTUMING

Please label all costumes and belongings with the student's name.

Any personal items should be left at home or with a parent / guardian. Only essential items are permitted in the dressing room.

BKS is not responsible for any lost or damaged property.

If a student is missing part of their costume, or their costume is damaged / dirty, they will not be allowed to perform in the show.

Aerial / Acro Students -

Students performing in Aerial / Acro should arrive to the theatre performance-ready. They should be wearing their BKS leotards and their black leggings on top, with hair and make-up completely done. All jewelry must be removed at home. Aerial / Acro routines are performed barefoot, but the students should wear shoes backstage until they perform. We suggest comfortable, slip-on shoes. Hair will be slicked straight back into a neat, high, ponytail with no part. Minimal BKS stage make-up is optional for younger students. If a student chooses to wear make-up, please follow the BKS stage make-up requirements.

Aerial / Acro and Dance Students -

Students performing in both Dance and Aerial / Acro should arrive to the theatre performance-ready. Aerial / Acro routines will be showcased first. The students should come wearing their BKS leotards with their black leggings on top. Hair and make-up must be complete upon arrival. All jewelry must be removed at home. Aerial / Acro routines are performed barefoot. Ballet routines are performed in pink Ballet shoes, and Tap routines in black Tap shoes. The students should wear shoes backstage until they perform. We

suggest comfortable, slip-on shoes. Hair will be slicked straight back into a neat, high, ponytail with no part. Minimal BKS stage make-up is optional for younger students. If a student chooses to wear make-up, please follow the BKS stage make-up requirements.

These students should bring any other required items with them to the dressing room (Ballet tutus, pink tights, pink Ballet shoes, black Tap shoes, hair pins for a bun, any additional accessories, etc.)

Dance Students -

Students performing with the Dance Program should arrive to the theatre performance-ready. Ballet routines will be showcased first. The students should come wearing their BKS leotards, Ballet tutus, pink Ballet shoes, and pink tights underneath. Hair and make-up must be complete upon arrival. All jewelry must be removed at home. Ballet routines are performed in pink Ballet shoes, and Tap routines in black Tap shoes. The students should wear shoes backstage until they perform. We suggest comfortable, slip-on shoes. Hair will be slicked straight back into a neat, high, bun with no part. Buns can be taken out after Ballet. Minimal BKS stage make-up is optional for younger students. If a student chooses to wear make-up, please follow the BKS stage make-up requirements.

These students should bring any other required items with them to the dressing room (black Tap shoes, any additional accessories, etc.)



Professional appearance is expected at all times from BKS students, in class and on stage. This is not only for safety reasons, but for a strong impression and classic visual. During performances, hair must be neatly set in the hairstyle chosen for the piece.

PERFORMANCES / EVENTS: Performers will need a hairbrush, a comb, elastics, hairnets, gel, hairspray, bobby pins (flat), and hair pins (U-shaped).

- 1. There should be no fly-aways, bangs, wispies, bumps, knots, etc. Hair must be slicked back with a tight and secure hold.
- 2. Arrive to the venue with your hair already completed. Ballet Routines will be performed in a high, flat, even bun. Aerial & Acro routines will be performed in a high, tight, ponytail with no part.
- 3. If a dancer's hair is too short to put in a ponytail or bun, please style it neatly off of the dancer's face.
- 4. Ponytails should be held up with at least two hair elastics to prevent slipping. All elastics, bobby pins, and hairnets must match the hair color. Bring extra supplies.
- 5. A headpiece should never fall off on stage. Pin all headpieces securely to the right side of the dancer's bun. Headpieces should lay flat and must not shift or move around as the dancer performs. A headpiece should add to, not distract from the dancer.
- 6. BKS Instructors will choose a specific hairstyle for each routine based on the choreography and costume. Hair styles are subject to change.
- 7. All dancers in a given routine must have the same hair style. Each routine must have a headpiece, and all dancers must have the same one.

BKS Makeup Requirements: Full BKS stage makeup is mandatory for Company Members, Ballet 4 - 6 Students, Lead Roles, and Ultimate Aerialists. Minimal stage makeup is optional for all Dance and Aerial students over 9 years old. There are no make-up requirements for Aerial & Acro Basics Students, or Ballet 1 - 3 students. If any younger dancers wish to wear stage makeup, please reference the BKS Makeup Guidelines listed below.


Why do dancers wear stage makeup? BKS Dancers wear stage makeup to accentuate their existing, natural beauty. Dance is a performing art, and that is why we love it. Performers are responsible for illustrating the meaning of their art to their audience - all the way up to the last row! Bright stage lights, far distances, and flashy costumes can make it easy to appear washed-out on stage. Using stage makeup techniques can drastically enhance the visibility of facial features, allowing your emotions and expressions shine through.
